



Mother's Day Bouquet

Make Mom a beautiful bouquet that will last forever!

Materials:

Colored Paper	Tissue Paper
Pipe Cleaners	Glue
Tape	Scissors
Decorations (Sequins, feathers, etc.)	

First make the vase for your bouquet. Roll a piece of construction paper to make a cone. Glue or tape the edge down to hold the form of the cone. Trim the top of the cone to make it even all the way around (like an ice cream cone). This is your vase. Decorate it by gluing or sticking on sequins, feathers, stickers, etc. Set it aside to dry.

To make the flowers, layer a couple of pieces of tissue paper together and fold like an accordion (over and under). Twist the end of a pipe cleaner around the middle. Leave the pipe cleaner long so it looks like a stem for the flower. Gently separate the layers of tissue paper to make the flower look more full. Make several flowers. You can decorate them with glitter or feathers or anything you like.

After you have several flowers made, tuck them into your vase. Mom will love it!
