



HEART BUTTERFLY

To make a butterfly from hearts, cut out the hearts on the attached page from paper in the colors of your choice. Two of the hearts are the wings, the third heart is the body. The butterfly will look more interesting if you use contrasting colors.

You can put the butterfly together so that it is a stand alone project, or it can be mounted on a new piece of paper. If it is going to stand alone, you may wish to use a sturdier paper or even craft foam.

The wings should be angled slightly and glued onto the body of the butterfly.

Punch two small holes fairly close together at the very top of the butterfly's body. The antennae will go here.

Bend a two inch piece of pipe cleaner into a "V" shape and push each end through the holes that you punched in the previous step.

This butterfly could be used as an addition to another project. Twist a pipe cleaner into a shape that resembles a spring. Attach one end of the spring to the butterfly and the other end to your project. It will look like the butterfly is hovering above our project. Can be used with the egg carton flower project or the floral wreath.
