

PAPER PLATE ELEPHANT

To make a paper plate elephant, cut out the ears and trunk that appear on the following pages from sturdy paper.

Paint the ears, nose and the back of a paper plate gray.

When they are all dry, attach the ears to the sides of the paper plate and glue the nose to the center of the plate. You could also cut a slit in the center of the plate and push about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch of the nose through the slit. Fold over the part you poked through and glue it to the back of the plate.

Next cut out the eyes and glue them to the elephant's face.

Variation: Instead of gluing eyes onto the elephant, cut holes and create an elephant mask.
