



ITSY BITSY SPIDER PROJECT

To make the itsy, bitsy spider, paint the back of a paper plate a dark color (black, brown, purple, etc.).

Cut 8 strips of paper about 1 inch wide and 6 inches long from construction paper that is the same color that you painted your plate.

Glue or staple four legs on each side of the front of the plate (the unpainted side) so that they stick out from under the plate. If you wish, make accordion folds in the legs to make them look bouncy.

Add eyes to the painted side of the plate.

If you would like, attach a long piece of string to the center of the plate to look like the spider is coming down the water spout to see you.

The spiders can be hung up or can be bounced up and down on the string.
